MISSION CANYON PARK

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Whose project is this?

This project is a partnership between the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) and the County of Los Angeles (landowner).

2. What measures are planned for security and fire protection?

MRCA has both a Ranger and Fire division and could provide routine patrols at the site. Additionally, water storage will be installed on-site for emergency use, if ever needed.

3. What will be the park's hours of operation be?

The park's hours will be sunrise to sunset (which vary throughout the year depending on daylight savings).

4. Will dogs be allowed?

Yes, dogs on-leash will be allowed.

5. Will vehicles, motor bikes, or horses be allowed to access the trail?

The trails within the park will only be accessible to pedestrians, bicycles, and emergency/maintenance vehicles.

6. Will the park be fenced?

There will be fencing and a gate at each of the proposed access points into the park, which will be opened and closed daily.

7. Is the site safe to access?

Yes. Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts currently monitor methane levels on-site (and will continue to do so) and have documented that levels have been well below the State regulated allowable emissions.

8. What measures will be put in place to keep the public away from homes?

The design team is considering natural barriers such as thorny shrubs. New trails are not planned to be located directly adjacent to private property. Signage and patrols can also encourage people to stay on trail.

9. Will a traffic light be installed on Sepulveda by the lower parking lot?

This will be determined based on the outcome of the current traffic study.

10. Can access to the park be limited to local residents only?

The project is located on publicly-owned land and will be improved with public funds. Therefore, this can not be a private park.
